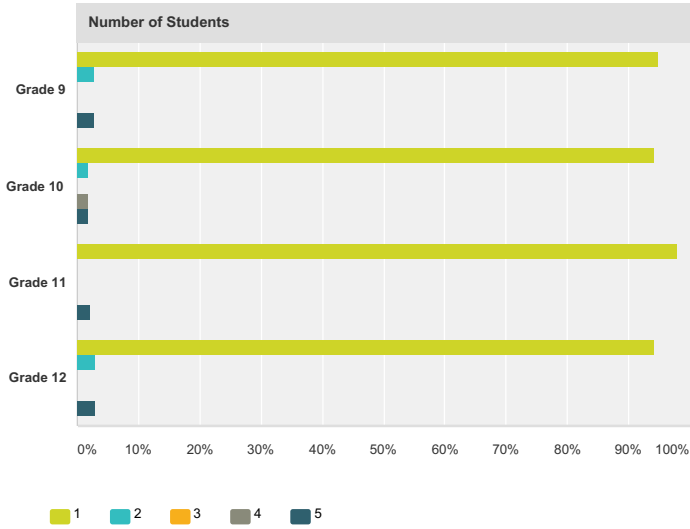


**Q1 How many children do you currently have in each of the following grade levels?**

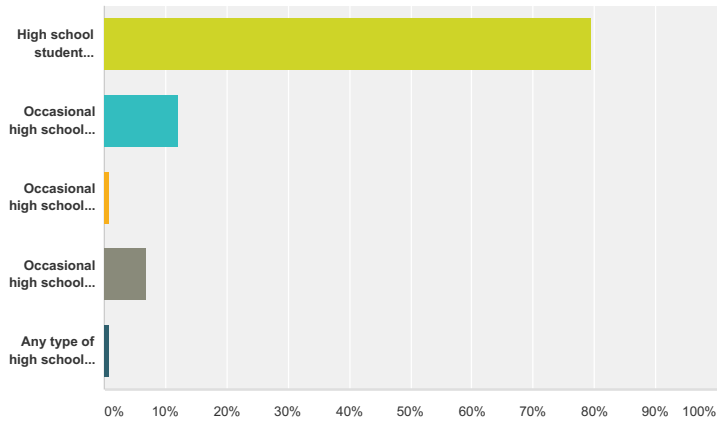

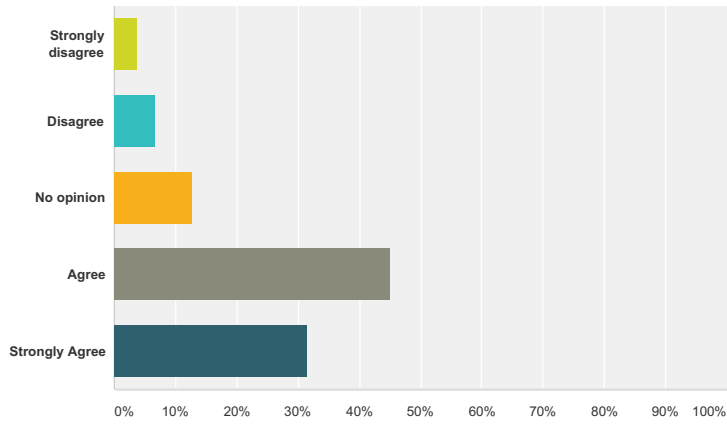

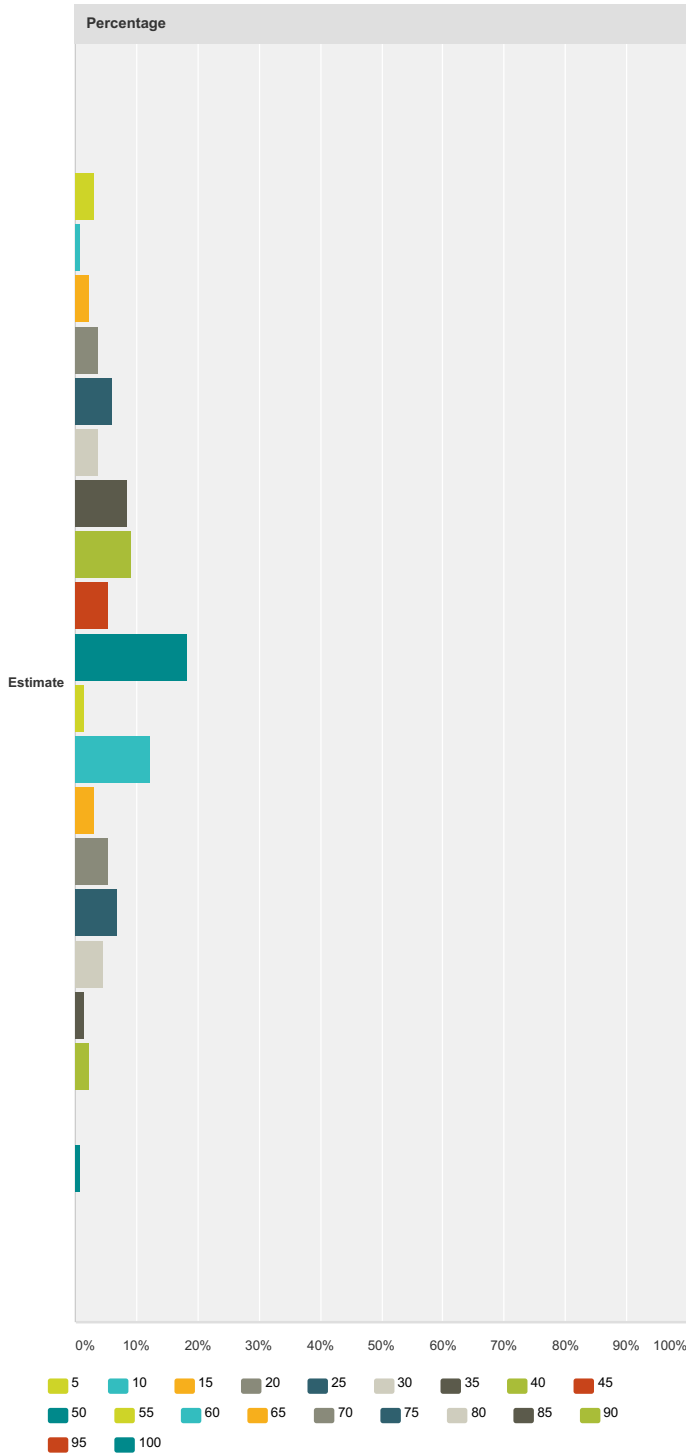

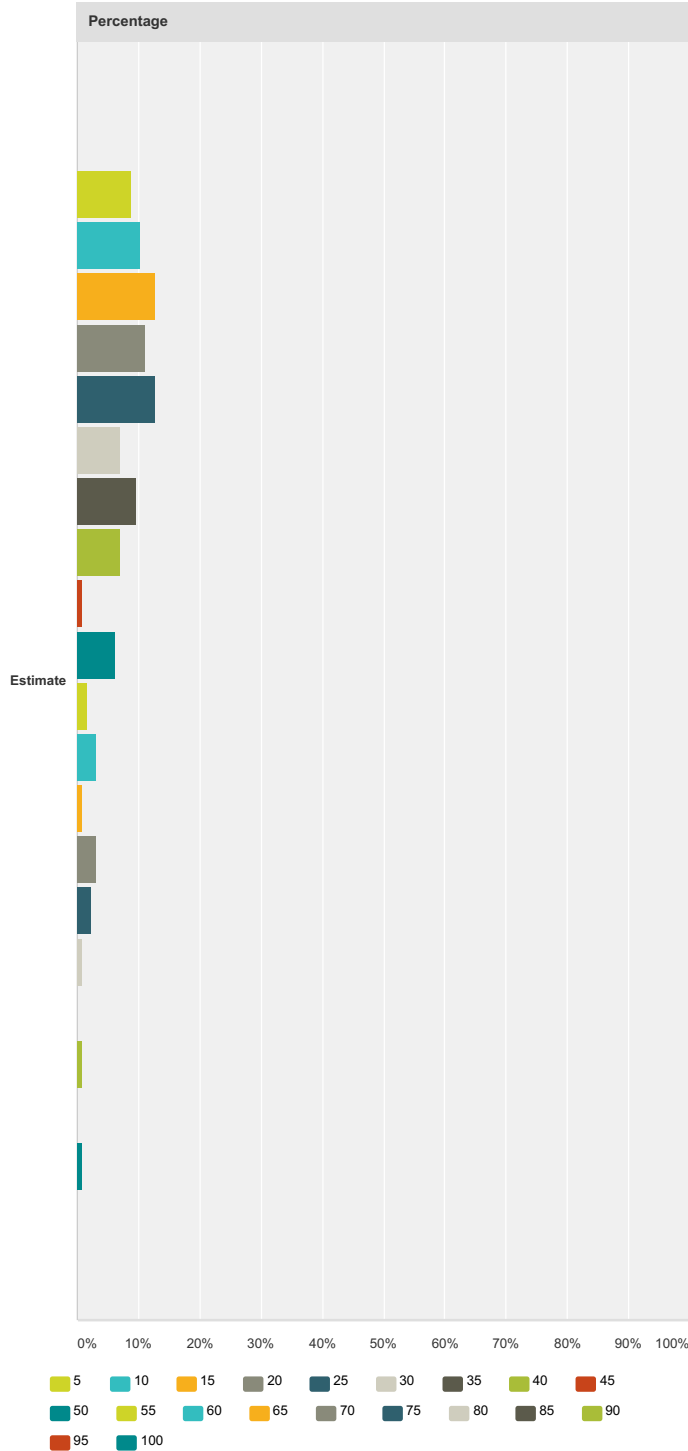

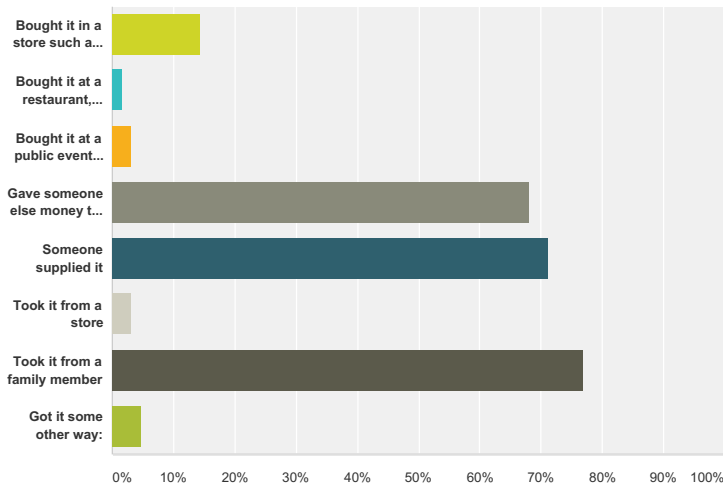

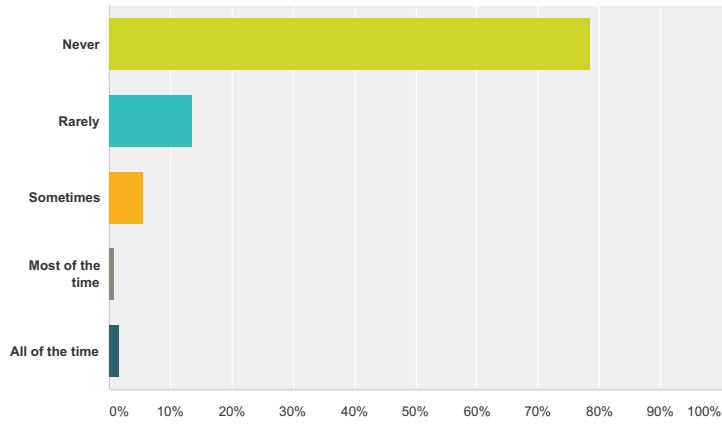

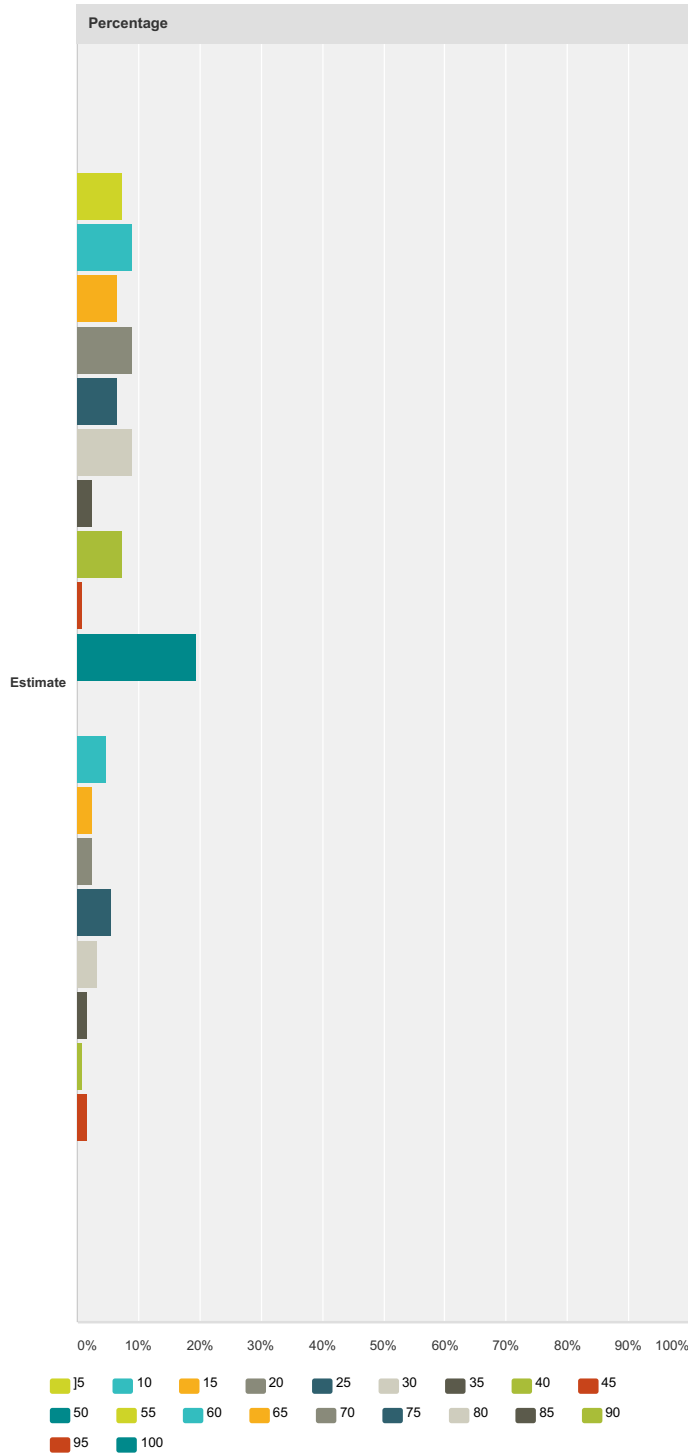

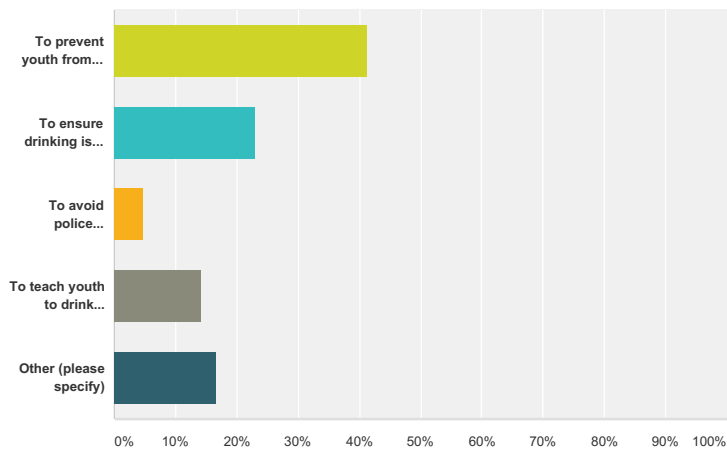

**Q9 What is the main reason you think some parents may allow their and other underage children to drink alcohol in their home? (select one)**

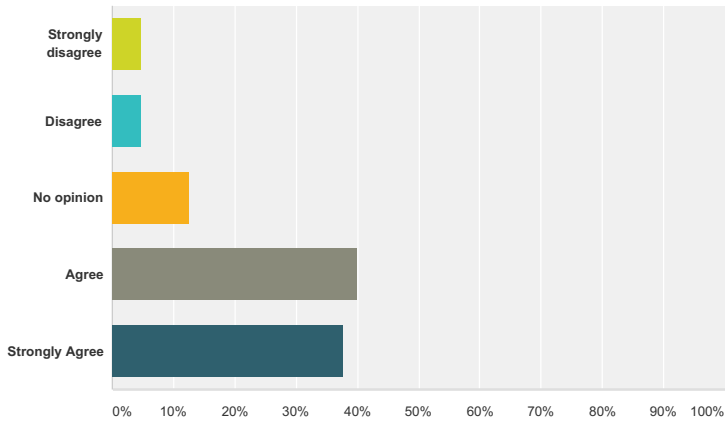

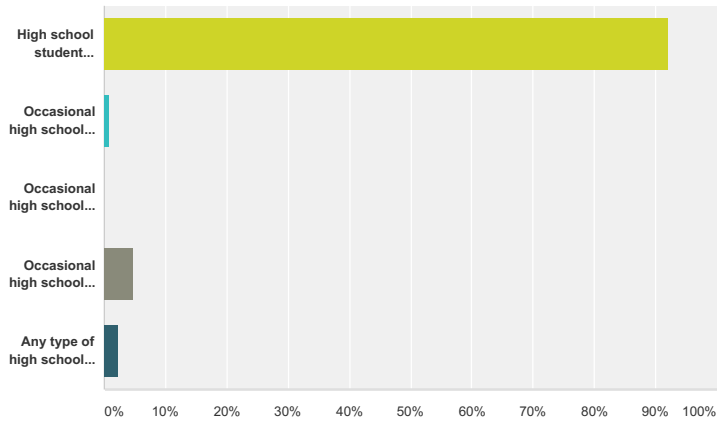

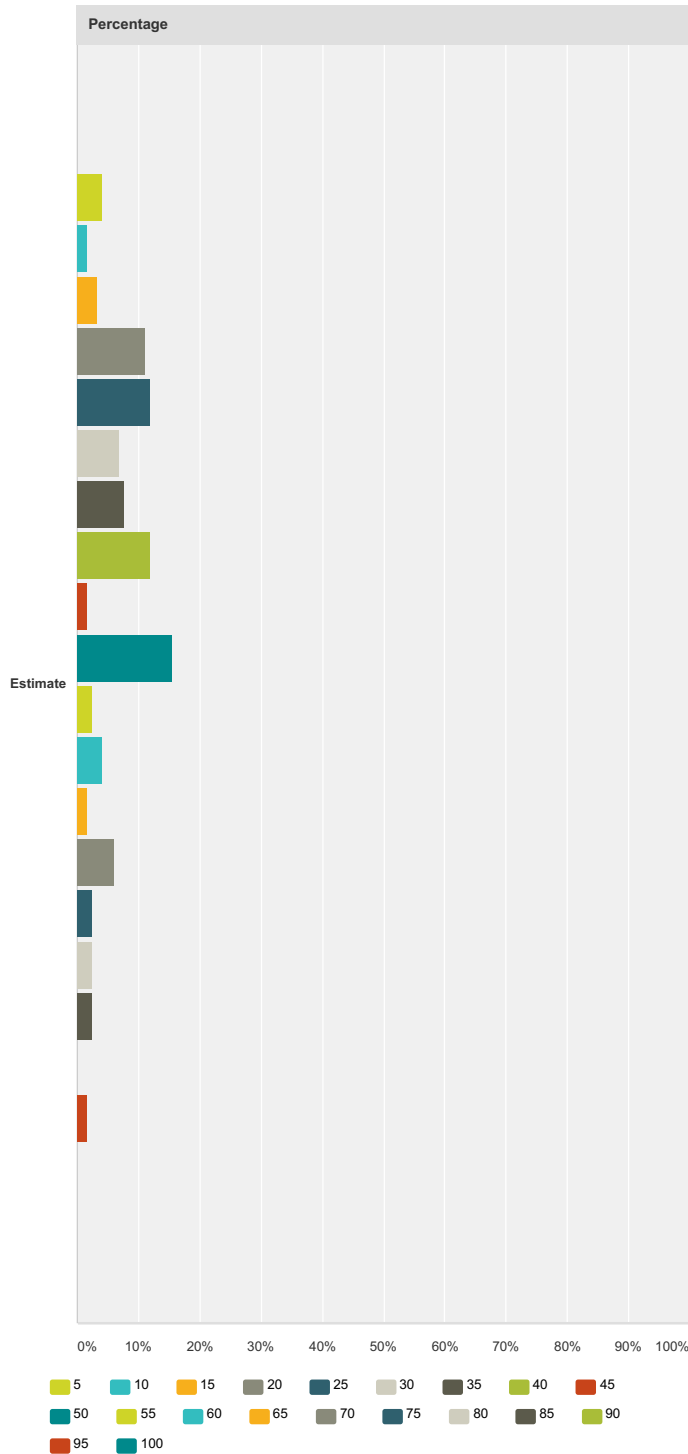

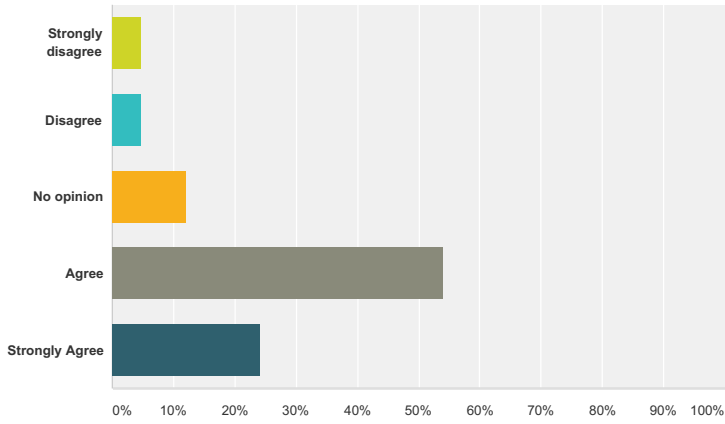

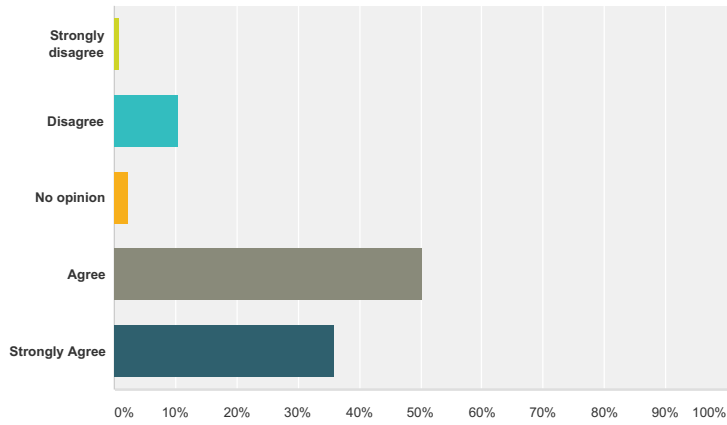

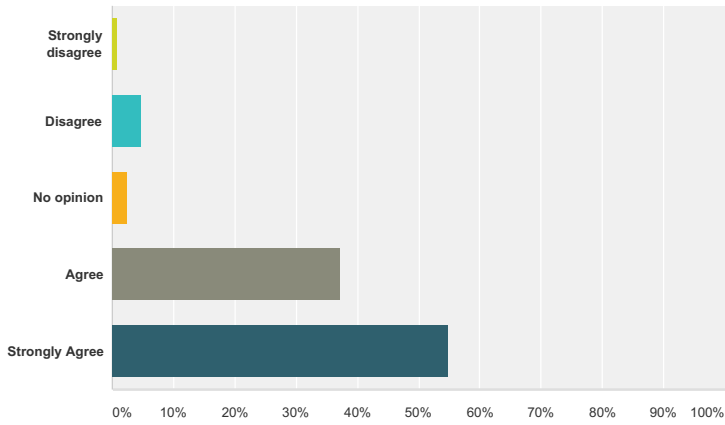

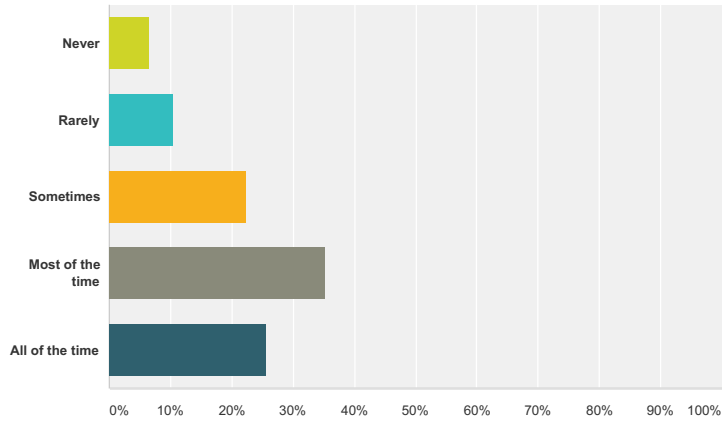

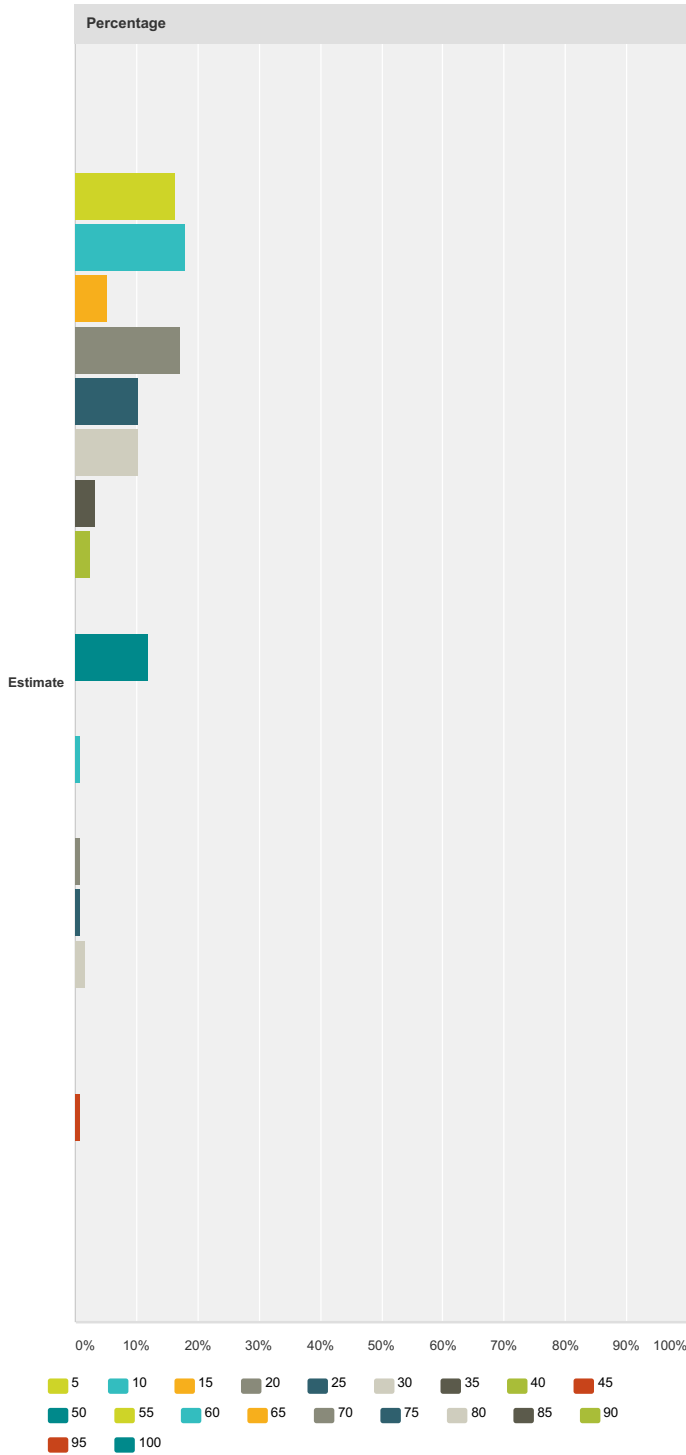

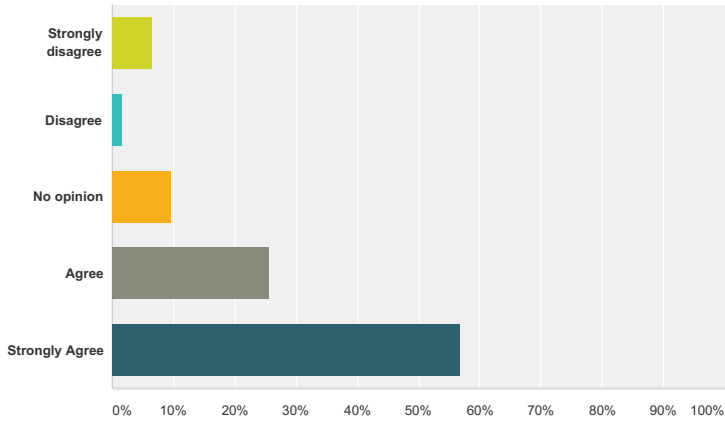

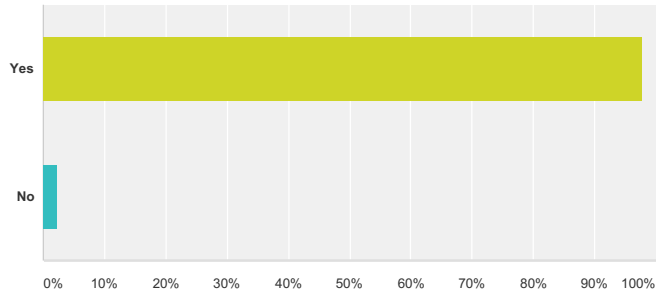

**Q19 Have you communicated to your children your family's guidelines and expectations associated with underage alcohol and drug use since the beginning of the current school year? (select one)**

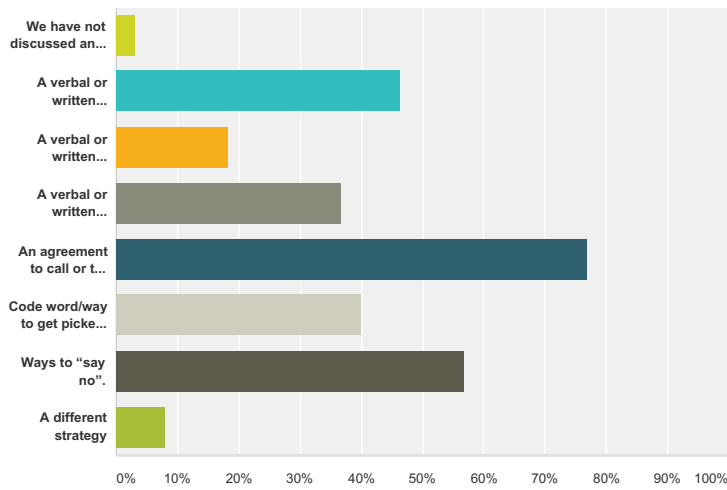

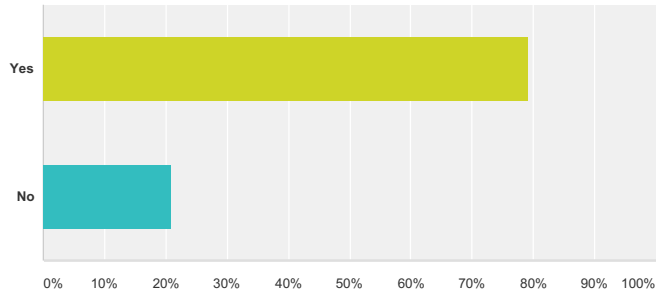

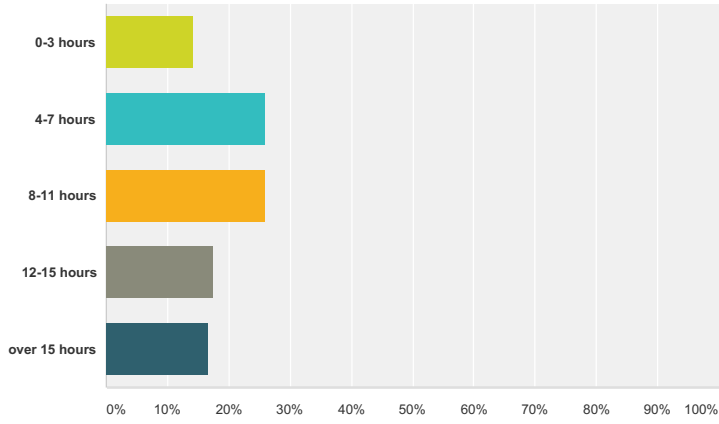

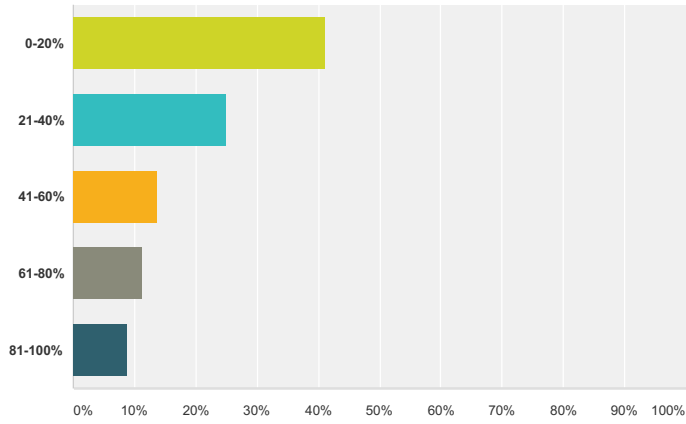

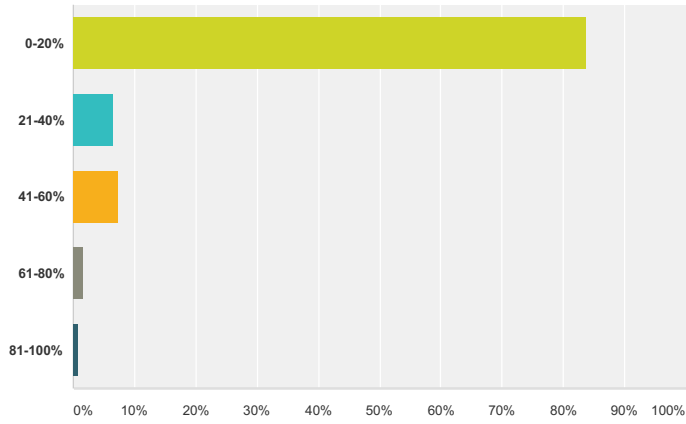

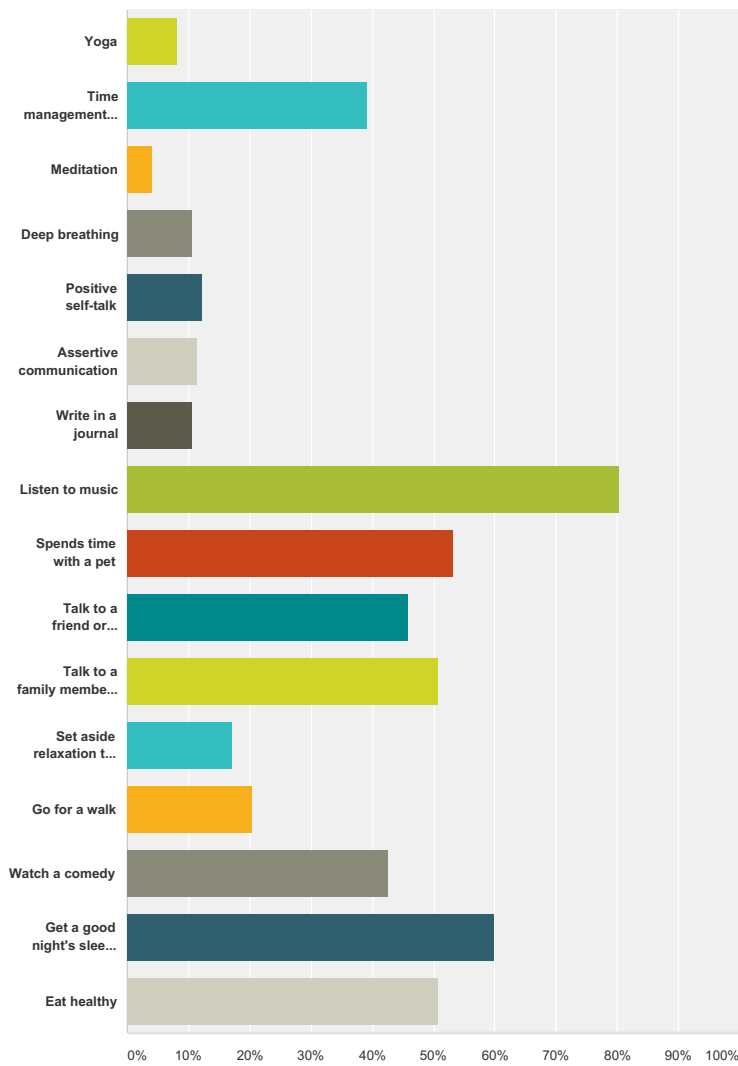

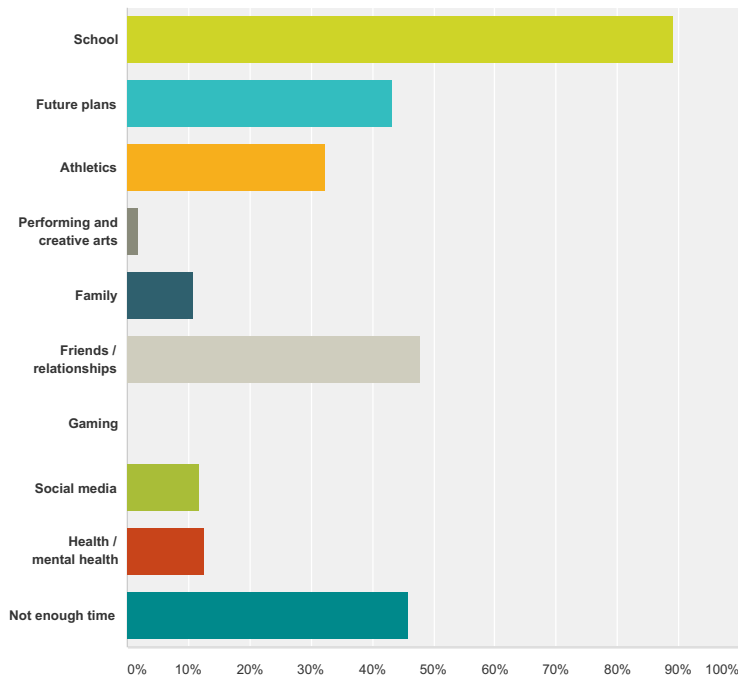
